

Frequently Asked Questions About the Defense Health Headquarters

BRAC Details

- **How many employees will be colocated during the move?**

Approximately 3,050 employees will move into the complex.

Timing and Facilities

- **When will the colocation occur?**

The colocation will happen from April 2012 through June 2012. Certain amenities will not be available until early September.

- **Will the campus meet environmental standards?**

All tenant improvement construction will meet Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Silver standards for Commercial Interiors. This includes offering Alternative Commuting Transportation credits to reduce pollution and land development impacts from automobile use.

- **Is there Metro or bus service to the DHHQ? If there is not direct Metro access, what type of travel/shuttle arrangements will be made?**

- Yes. DHHQ will be served by Metro Bus route 1A.
- Shuttle service to the DHHQ from the Pentagon Metro Station (Blue and Yellow lines) runs from 5:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., departing every 15 to 20 minutes.
- Shuttle service to the DHHQ from the Dunn Loring-Merrifield Metro Station (Orange line) runs from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., departing every 30 minutes during peak hours.

- **What amenities are in the surrounding area?**

The area around the DHHQ has many amenities, including banking; convenience grocery and a supermarket; day care facilities; a fire station; hair salon; hardware store; laundry and dry cleaners; library; medical, dental, and senior care facilities; park; pharmacy; post office; school; commercial office space; community center; restaurants; and other services.
