

SUBJECT: Policy on New TRICARE Pharmacy Copayments and Elimination of Active Duty
Family Member (ADFM) TRICARE Prime Copayments

The purpose of this memorandum is to introduce the new TRICARE Pharmacy copayments and to announce the elimination of copayments for care provided to family members of active duty personnel enrolled in TRICARE Prime. These changes are effective on April 1, 2001. A summary of the copayment changes is attached. I request your assistance in communicating this information to our Active Duty Family Members (ADFM).
