Checklist and Certification for Minimum Level of Enhanced Safeguarding for Unclassified DoD Information

TYPE OF ACTION: TMA Program Policy

EFFECTIVE DATE: August 26, 2011

SUMMARY: The referenced DTM established policy to provide adequate security for all unclassified DoD information on non-DoD information systems. Appropriate requirements were to be incorporated into all contracts, grants, and other legal agreements or understandings with non-DoD entities. TMA leadership has determined to enable implementation of the DTM policy in current and new solicitations and contracts, in lieu of any existing DIACAP provisions (or other existing provisions for safeguarding unclassified DoD information), using the referenced special provision and certification

and checklist, attached hereto. On a case-by-case basis, it shall be the contracting officer's election and decision to incorporate these enabled provisions in the document, after coordination with the respective program manager and if otherwise approved by the Deputy Director, TMA. If incorporated, these provisions will replace DIACAP provisions addressing like subject matter. ANY SUCH INCORPORATION OF THESE PROVISIONS MUST OCCUR AND BE EFFECTIVE NO LATER THAN MIDNIGHT, AUGUST 31, 2012.

ACTION REQUIRED: Contracting officers shall consider the incorporation of the referenced provisions as soon as feasible and take solicitation or contract action accordingly, as they may determine, within the time period afforded above.

This Policy Alert is effective on the date of issuance and remains in effect until revised, superseded, or until otherwise rescinded.
