Prohibition on Contracting with the Enemy and Access to Contractor and Subcontractor Records in the U.S. Central Command Theater of Operations

TYPE OF ACTION: Class Deviation

EFFECTIVE DATE: January 26, 2012

SUMMARY: This class deviation implements statutory provisions of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2012 (Public Law 112-81) as follows: Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS) 252.225-7993, Prohibition on Contracting with the Enemy in the United States Central Command Theater of Operations (DEVIATION 2012-O0005) (JAN 2012); and DFARS 252.225-7994, Additional Access to Contractor and Subcontractor Records in the United States Central Command Theater of Operations (DEVIATION 2012-O0005) (JAN 2012). ACTION REQUIRED: Effective immediately, contracting officers shall comply with the policy in this deviation and incorporate the clauses referenced in the [memorandum](#) in solicitations and contracts with an estimated value of more than \$100,000 that are being, or will be, performed in the U.S. Central Command Theater of Operations.

This Policy Alert is effective on the date indicated above, and remains in effect until revised or otherwise rescinded.
