### **TRICARE Acquisition Directive 15-04, Rev 000, Resolving Contract Audit Recommendations**

**TYPE OF ACTION:** TMA Policy and Procedure

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** July 19, 2012

**SUMMARY:** The TRICARE Acquisition Directive (TAD) 15-04, Rev. 000, Resolving Contract Audit Recommendations and its companion document TRICARE Management Activity (TMA) Procedures, Guidance, and Information (PGI) 215.406-90 establish mandatory policy and procedures for resolving Significant Disagreements with Defense Contract Audit Agency contract audit recommendations. It prescribes the escalation path, both within and beyond TMA, to achieving resolution.

**ACTION REQUIRED:** TMA personnel that participated in the establishment of the pre-negotiation objectives and in the review and/or resolution of the Significant Disagreements shall comply with the TAD and PGI.
