**SUBJECT: Mandatory Revised Guidelines for Federal Workforce Drug Testing
Programs**

Effective October 1, 2010, Department of Defense (DoD) agencies conducting civilian drug testing must comply with all requirements of the revised mandatory guidelines for the Federal Workplace Drug Testing Program, as published in the Federal Register/Vol. 73, No. 228, pages 71858-71907, <http://edocket.access.gpo.gov/2008/pdf/e8-26726.pdf>. The new guidelines allow testing for the direct screening of the heroin metabolite, 6-acetylmorphine, and ecstasy drugs: Methylenedioxyamphetamine (MDA), Methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA), and Methylenedioxyethylamphetamine (MDEA), known as "Eve." For consistency purposes, all DoD agency specimens are to be tested for: marijuana; cocaine; opiates (codeine/morphine and heroin); phencyclidine; amphetamines (amphetamine/methamphetamine, MDMA, MDA and MDEA).
