Objectives:

1. Efficiently search and access clinical content
2. Recall the two levels of care addressed in Recovery Facility Care
3. Interpret the Clinical Indications for Admission to Recovery Facility
4. Define Length of Stay
5. Describe how to apply Recovery Facility Care's Treatment Course

Intended Audience: Participants will include Military Treatment Facility (MTF) Medical Management (MM) staff to include nurses, physicians, utilization-case-disease managers, medical support staff, administrative staff, clinical case managers.

Description: The course provides an overview of how to navigate, search and apply Recovery Facility Care guidelines to manage patients at the inpatient rehabilitation (IRF) and sub-acute medical/skilled nursing (SNF) levels of care. The course incorporates case studies to reinforce accurate application of the Recovery Facility Care guidelines based on actual clinical information. This course has a duration of 2 hours.

Registration is free. Please follow these steps to register (note that you must register 24 hours in advance)

2. Once you have gained access to the MHS Learn site, click the "MHS Staff Training" link at the top of the page.
3. When the "MHS Staff Training" page loads, please log in by clicking the button on the right side of the page. (Note: CAC login will not be available until late November 2011. If you do not have a username and password, you can sign up via the "click here to register" button below the login fields).
4. After logging in, type "Milliman" in the "Search Catalog" box at the top left of your screen.
5. A list of all upcoming Milliman learning activities will be displayed. Choose from the list of courses offered by clicking on one of the "Scheduled Learning" offerings (Ambulatory Care; Behavioral Health

Guidelines; General Recovery Guidelines and Ambulatory Care; Inpatient and Surgical Care; Recovery Facility Care).

6. Upon selecting the course you are interested in, a page will load displaying dates and times for upcoming training opportunities. Click on the course offering with the most convenient date and time.
7. When the new page loads, click “enroll” at the top right of your screen.
8. A new page will load confirming that you have successfully enrolled in the course. This page will provide details on the course schedule, dial in information, and the opportunity to “download schedule” for the course.
9. You will be sent a follow up email with details on how to access the web portion of the training.
