Objective: Review 2012 HEDIS measures, how they are determined and brief background information. Discuss measures that are tracked and reported centrally by military treatment facilities.

Description:

1. HEDIS is a tool used by more than 90 percent of America's health plans to measure performance on important dimensions of care and service. Altogether, HEDIS consists of 76 measures across 5 domains of care. Health plans also use HEDIS results themselves to see where they need to focus their improvement efforts.
2. Identify 2012 HEDIS measures and their applicability.
3. Discuss measures that are centrally tracked by Navy, Army and Air Force.
4. Discuss best practices or issues with data collection, management and reporting.
