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# Introduction



- Air Force (AF) pharmacies provide valuable clinical services
  - Increase access to care by expanding services in Medical Treatment Facilities (MTF)
- Objective: gain understanding of pharmacist-run clinics currently provided
  - Long-term goal:
    - Standardize clinic protocols across AF facilities
    - Increase services provided by pharmacies

# Methods




- An electronic survey was sent out to 77 AF MTFs
- Each pharmacy received a code to identify the responses
- Collected demographic information and services provided
- Survey available for two weeks

# Results



- 67/77 Air Force pharmacies responded to the survey (87% response rate)

# Conclusion



- Study reveals a wide variety of pharmacist-run clinics provided
  - 274 clinics reported
- Future goals
  - Standardize pharmacist-run clinic protocols
    - Reduce time to get started
