If you or your loved one is experiencing a behavioral health emergency, please call 911 or go to the nearest emergency room.

TRICARE beneficiaries do not need prior authorization for emergency care, but must contact the regional contractor within 24 hours or the next business day. If admitted, beneficiaries must report the admission to the regional contractor within 72 hours.

Walter Reed National Military Medical Center (WRNMMC) is committed to ensuring you and your family receive the best behavioral health care experience.

We offer non-emergency outpatient services for military service members and their families, including children (age 5-12), adolescents (age 13-17, 18 if attending high school), and adults.

Inpatient behavioral health services are available for adults only. All civilian adult admissions at WRNMMC must be voluntary and by referral from the patient's behavioral health care team. Voluntary admission is when the patient consents (agrees) to be admitted for behavioral health services, and is not seeking care because of a court order. The age at which patients are legally able to provide consent for their treatment varies by state. In Maryland, consent can be decided by patients 16 years old and older.

What is a Behavioral Health Emergency?

A behavioral health emergency is when the patient is at immediate risk of serious harm to self or others, and needs immediate continuous skilled observation.

Preparing for a Behavioral Health Emergency

We want you to be prepared for an emergency situation so you can get the services you need when you need them. Be sure to talk with your behavioral health care team about preparing a plan that includes who to call and where to go to ensure you receive the best possible care.
